



STATEMENT REGARDING PROPOSITION 65

The California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, commonly known as "Proposition 65," was enacted by California ballot in November 1986 and intended by its authors to protect California citizens from substances determined to cause cancer or birth defects or other reproductive harm. Under the administration of Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA), there are now over 900 chemicals considered or listed under Proposition 65.

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide notice to Californians when there is potential exposure to significant amounts of certain chemicals in the products they purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. Businesses are required to give a "clear and reasonable warning" to individuals before "knowingly and intentionally" exposing them to listed Proposition 65 chemicals unless the business can demonstrate that the exposure is so small that it causes "no significant risk" of cancer or "no observable effect" with regard to reproductive toxins. The OEHHA has determined "safe harbor" levels of exposure, below which no warning is required.
